School's Commitment

Saltney Ferry C.P. School will:

Parents'/Guardians' Commitment

Parents and Carers will:

- See that their child goes to school regularly, on time (8.55 a.m.) and properly equipped, informing the school as soon as possible regarding the reasons for any absence.
- Ensure that a note or message of explanation is provided in the event of absence.
- Make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect their children's work or behaviour.
- Make sure that their child wears Saltney Ferry school uniform, supports the school's policy on dress code for daily wear and for P.E. and regularly brings all equipment and kit needed for school.
- Support the school's expectations of acceptable behaviour within the school environment.
- Encourage and support their child in home learning.
- Attend parents' evenings and discussions about their child's progress.
- Get to know about their child's life at school.

Pupils' Commitment

Pupils will:

- Always be polite, courteous and considerate to all pupils and adults within the school.
- Always abide by the school's code of conduct, maintain high standards of discipline both inside and outside the classroom.
- Be punctual and attend regularly.
- Be dressed correctly in Saltney Ferry school uniform.
- Behave in a way which will not damage the good name of the school and their family at any time, both inside and outside school.
- Take pride in the school and the local environment.
- Work to the best of their ability at all times.
- Ensure that Home Learning is always completed and returned to school on time.
